Revised Proceedings of the meeting of the Committee constituted by the Vice Chancellor to reconsider the rules regarding guidelines on determination of Uniform Span Period to qualify a degree held on 28.01.2019 at 4.00 PM in the office of the Controller of Examinations.

The following were present :-

Earlier the Committee was constituted to consider the issues for conducting the examinations of the students of Regular Courses as well as Distance Education courses alongwith Mercy Chance and gave its recommendations. Accordingly the committee submitted its report. After this report a letter of UGC dated 15.10.2015 was marked to the Controller of Examinations to implement the guidelines of UGC regarding minimum and maximum duration for the courses in which a student may be allowed to qualify for a Degree which are available on UGC website. Therefore, the committee reached on this conclusion that the provision already available in the ordinance/prospectus of the courses run in this University as well as its affiliated colleges and Distance Education Courses may be revised as under in light of UGC guidelines and these rules may be implemented on those students who will complete the minimum duration of their course in the year 2019:-

(i) MERCY CHANCE	
Existing	Proposed
Grant of mercy chance is allowed to those students who got re-appear and could not pass the examination within maximum duration of programme on the recommendation of the Committee constituted for the purpose and for those students who want improvement of "Division"/"Score" after maximum duration of programme. Such candidates will have to pay a fee of Rs. 5000/- per paper subject to a maximum of Rs. 10,000/- per semester and the candidate will have to appear in the even semester with the exams of even semester and the odd semester with the exam of odd semester.	Grant of mercy chance is allowed within maximum duration of course i.e. N+2 (where N stands for normal duration of course) to a student who got reappear and has availed two chances to clear the re-appear paper (s) of a particular semester/year, on recommendations of Chairperson of the Deptt. Director (HSB/DE), Principal of the concerned affiliated College. Such candidates will have to pay a fee of Rs.5,000/- per paper subject to maximum of Rs. 10,000/- per semester/year. In this case may be and the candidate will have to appear in the examination as and when to be conducted for that particular semester. The schedule for filling examination form for mercy chance students will remain the same as notified from time to time for odd/even/annual exams without late fee. An application for mercy chance will be entertained after expiry of scheduled date of without late fee. NOTE: For B. Pharm. course (w.e.f. academic session 2017-18), the maximum duration of course shall be double the actual duration of the programme, as per PCI regulations 2011.

(ii) IMPROVEMENT

A candidate who has passed the final examinations of this University and is desirous of improving his/her performance, will be allowed to appear in the end semester examinations (Major Tests) only as an ex-student in even/odd semester examinations. Simultaneously, twice within the maximum period permissible. Such a candidate in the first instance shall be required to intimate all the paper(s) in which he/she would like to improve his/her performance. If he/she does not improve his/her performance, in any semester he/she shall be eligible to do so in the following examinations which would be treated as second chance. The candidate shall appear in examinations as per current syllabus, provided for students of that academic session. If any paper has been deleted altogether from the course/paper, the question paper will be supplied accordingly to the syllabus of the last examination held by the University in that paper. The candidate can appear for improvement examination within maximum permissible period for the programme concerned after passing the final examination.

A candidate who has passed the final examinations of the University and is desirous of improving his/her performance, will be allowed to appear in the end semester examinations (Major Tests) only as an ex-student in odd/even semester/ annual examinations, as the case may be twice, upto one year after the maximum period permissible N+2 (where N stands for normal duration of course). Those candidates who have taken Migration Certificate from this University will not be eligible for appearing in improvement examination. Further, those eligible students who want improvement of "Division"/"Score" after minimum duration of programme may apply with the recommendation of Chairperson of the Deptt., Director(HSB)/(DE), Principal of the concerned affiliated College with normal fee as per notified schedule of examinations within permissible maximum duration of course. After maximum duration (N+2), the candidates will have to pay a fee of Rs.5000/- per paper, subject to maximum of Rs.10000/- per semester/year, as the case may be and the candidates will have to appear in the examination as and when being conducted for that particular semester/years. The schedule for filling examination form for improvement students will remain the same as notified from time to time for odd/even/annual exams without late fee. No application for improvement will be entertained after expiry of scheduled date of without late fee.


(iii) UNIVERSITY MEDALS

EXISTING

University Medal will be awarded to a student of university and its affiliated institution who secures first division and stands first in the final examination of the course in the first attempt or through re-evaluation of any answer sheet.


Proposed

University Medal will be awarded to a student of the University including its affiliated colleges who secures first division and stands first in the entire course examination of the UG/PG in the first attempt including awards of re-evaluation of any answer sheet, if any.
