Subject: Regarding participation in the "Earn-While-You-Learn (EWYL)" Scheme implemented in the Institute w.e.f. July, 2026.

On the subject cited above, all the students of Electrical Engineering 6th semester are hereby informed that the "Earn-While-You-Learn (EWYL)" Scheme of Directorate of Technical Education, Haryana has been implemented in the Institute w.e.f. July, 2026 for the final year students of upcoming session 2026-2027.

This scheme aims to provide students with real-time practical exposure, inculcate with ethics, support them financially, and simultaneously address manpower shortages in non-teaching areas. The initiative aligns with NEP-2020, which emphasizes experimental learning, industry relevance, skill enhancement, and equitable opportunities.

Objective of the scheme:-

- To utilize students as a resource in institutional operations.
- To provide hands-on job experience enhancing employability
- To instill dignity of labour and work ethics.
- To engage students in meaningful activities within the Institute.
- To support financially weaker students.
- To improve institutional functioning by optimizing human resource.
- To reduce workload on understaffed non-teaching departments.
- To improve utilization of Centres of Excellence (CoE)
- To integrate experimental and work-based learning as per NEP-2020.

Scope of Implementation: The scheme shall be implemented in a phased manner. Initially, at least 20% of the students from total strength of the Institute, branch-wise, may be engaged under the scheme, with scope for enhancement based on performance and requirement.

Nature of Work (Illustrative):

A. Laboratories and Workshops

- Equipment handling, maintenance and upkeep.
- Assistance in lab setups and conduct of practicals.
- Minor repair work (Electrical, electronics, plumbing, furniture, CCTV)
- Deployment of DLMT students in laboratory activities.
- Website development, software updates, system maintenance.
- Engagement students for architectural/ civil surveys, measurements, drafting, or preparation of building / repair plans of Government building, under proper supervision.

B. Library

- Cataloging and arranging books.
- Issue/ return support after regular hours.
- Register and record maintenance

C. Office and Administration

- Data entry, file and inventory maintenance.
- Student attendance, hostel, and examination record preparation.
- Support in computer, library, administrative and photography- related tasks.


Working Hours and Remuneration:

- Payment issued on verified attendance and work quality.

Selection procedure


- Applications to be invited at the start of academic year from the Final year students.

- Department to allocate work based on need assessment.

Minor Repair Work (Electrical, CCTV Camera) For Electricity Maintenance Section of the Institute	02	In order to look after the work of electricity repair and maintenance of various buildings of the Institute such as Academic Block, Mechanical Workshop block, Street Lighting system, Boys Hostel, Girls Hostel, Residences, Sewage Treatment Plant, Water Works etc. as well as repair and maintenance of ACs, Water Coolers, CCTV cameras, there is only 01 Electrician working on HKRNL and 01 Electrician in working as Apprentice under NAPS Scheme. The findings given in Energy Audit report are also to be taken care and intime execution on the submissions of EA report is also needed So, in order to carry out the repair work smoothly, more manpower is required for the above said works & students under Earn-Way-to-Learn (EWYL) Scheme may be engaged for this purpose.
